

Financial aid is offered to all eligible students. PacRim is approved and participates in the Title IV Federal Student Aid program. The university manages three categories of financial aid: (1) Federally funded grants and loans; (2) University scholarships; and (3) Private Donor scholarships.

- (1) Federally funded grants and loans; Federal financial aid is available to eligible students in the form of grants and loans:
 - Federal Pell Grant
 - FSEOG (Federal Secondary Educational Opportunity Grant)
 - Federal Direct Loans
 - Federal PLUS Loans
 - Federal Work Study

All undergraduate students are encouraged to submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at FAFSA.GOV.

- (2) University scholarships University scholarships supplement federal financial aid for students in need. The Po'okela scholarship for graduating high school seniors is funded from this award budget.
- (3) Private Donor scholarships There are four scholarships that are funded annually by donors:
- Charlie Soon Memorial Scholarship
- Chenin Blanc Mun Fuung Iglowitz Scholarship
- Kellie Ann Andrade Scholarship
- Dr. Elizabeth Misao Keith International Scholarship

Private Donor Scholarship applications are made available before the start of the next Academic Year.
